Organ 'Transplant': Many at OLSE will notice the 'new' organ which was installed last week. It is, in fact, a great tribute to our resident organists, Judith and Ken, that they have been able to play for us so well over the last few years with so many defects challenging them. The new organ became available locally and represents a good deal for us, so we hope that this one will last for many years to come.

The Statue of Our Lady, Queen of Poland in our grounds now has a 'house', thanks to the generous workings of the Knights of St. Columba [King's Lynn] and the Knights of Columbus, USA [Lakenheath].
